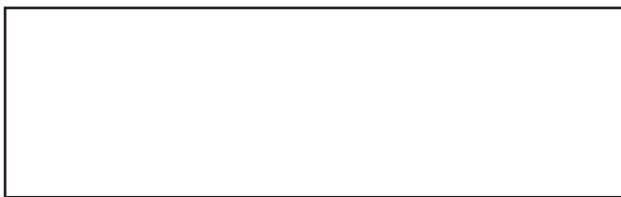
Due to the increase of all costs, the Board of Officers has had to make the incredibly difficult decision to raise prices.
