ADMINISTRATOR'S CORNER

August is here and the weather to this point has been very strange to be sure. Hope your summer so far has been good.

Some new by-laws changes were made this past international convention, here are the three most important; (1) a members spouse that is not a member must sign the guest book each time they visit the lodge; (2) a members significant other; man or women must be enrolled as a member of the chapter or lodge on their third visit; (3) starting this August 1st a lodge man can sign up a woman into the chapter and a chapter woman can sign up a man into the lodge.
