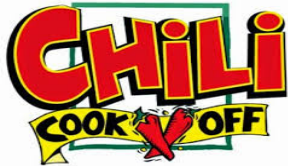
We are so busy these days making many plans to enjoy this coming year. Have any interest in joining the Mooseriders? The applications are on our board in the main hallway in the Moose.
