Our Kenosha Moose Legion picnic is June 17 at 5 PM. As always participants are asked to bring a dish to pass.


The Kenosha Moose Legion Committee meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month. Our next meeting is on Tuesday, February 9, at 6:30 PM.














