Private Policy: Some Details And Clarification On Its Importance

The Private Policy of The Moose is often misunderstood. When this policy is ignored, the lodge and our Fraternity are put at risk.

The Private Policy of The Moose is often misunderstood. When this policy is ignored, the lodge and our Fraternity are put at risk. Being selected for membership is an honor and a privilege which should be protected by all. One of the ways to do that is by adhering to the Private Policy.

The Private Policy is simple: Either you are a member of a lodge, or you are a guest. A guest is defined as anyone who is not a member of the lodge, which includes a member's spouse if he or she is not a member.

Guests:

- Must be signed in when entering the lodge.
- May not make purchases.
- Must leave when the member leaves.

Members are responsible for the decorum of their guests at all times. A member may be brought before the board of officers if an incident occurs involving their guest which results in an incident report. Remember that each lodge gets to vote on applications for membership and choose who they wish to join their lodge and our Fraternity. This is the backbone of a private organization.

A lodge member is in arrears on his or her dues immediately after the expiration of the month during which their dues were to be paid.

When in arrears, a member:

- Is considered "not in good standing."
- Cannot attend lodge meetings.
- Does not have social quarters privileges.
- Becomes a guest after 12 months.

Members are responsible for knowing their dues date and paying them on-time. A lodge that serves food or drink to an expired member is putting their private status at risk.

It is imperative that we are diligent in checking membership cards, selling merchandise only to members and only allowing access to members, their immediate families and qualified (invited and accompanied) guests.

Other than for lodge business, the use of the lodge facility must be limited to "recognized" community service functions, for which dispensation must be obtained from the Chief Compliance Office, and for legitimate family social occasions.

Be proud to be a Moose and show your card when asked! ■

NEW DUES STRUCTURE AS OF APRIL 30TH 2021



All lodge dues are now \$55 (for men and women). It is also \$55 to renew ALL dues. There is a promotion until July 31st which waves the \$20 application fee.

If a man wants to join the Moose Legion it is an additional \$16. If a woman wants to join the WOTM Chapter it is an additional \$15*. You must be a member of the lodge to be a member of the Moose Legion or WOTM Chapter. Any member can sponsor a new male or female member into the Lodge, but a male must sponsor a male into the Moose Legion and a female must sponsor a female into the WOTM Chapter.

*If you were a member prior to April 30, 2021 and your dues remain current, your Chapter dues are covered for three years from your WOTM expiration date on your WOTM card as of April 30, 2021

NEWS FROM MOOSE RIDERS

Hello Riders? We are pleased to announce our first "destination" trip of 2021. We will be going to The Dirty Turtle in Mauston on Saturday, August 7th on a boat cruise (The Cruisin Turtle). This is back by popular demand and those of you that went with us a few years ago know how much fun it is. Following are the details:

The date of August is actually Mauston's "Waterfest" weekend. The Cruisin Turtle (the boat we were on a few years ago) is being leased to Juneau County for Waterfest. I have been in contact with Juneau County and have reserved 25 seats on the boat. The cost for the boat is \$25/per person. This block of seats will be on-hold until the end of June at which time we have to give them a final count and pay for the seats. After the end of June, those seats that we don't take will be opened up to the general public. The boat leaves at sunset (8-8:30Pm) and cruises around the lake to an island where they will be shooting off fireworks. The fireworks display is supposed to be good and we will have the best seats in the house for the show. There will be some food on board (sub sandwiches, snacks and beverages) but we will be allowed to bring our own food and beverages on board. This is a rain or shine event and the \$25/per person is non-refundable unless Waterfest cancels the boat due to severe weather.

If I am not at the meeting, please give the money to our treasurer Debbie. Again, the \$25 is non-refundable unless the event is canceled by Juneau County. We will discuss plans for the event in further detail at our July Meeting.
