NEW DUES STRUCTURE AS OF APRIL 30TH 2021



All lodge dues are now \$55 (for men and women). It is also \$55 to renew ALL dues.

This promotion ended July 31st which waved the \$20 application fee.

If a man wants to join the Moose Legion it is a an additional \$16.

If a woman wants to join the WOTM Chapter it is an additional \$15*.

You must be a member of the lodge to be a member of the Moose Legion or or WOTM Chapter. Any member can sponsor a new male or female member into the Lodge, but a male must sponsor a male into the Moose Legion and a female must sponsor a female into the WOTM Chapter.

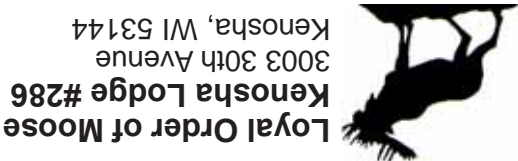
