### **NEW DUES STRUCTURE AS OF APRIL 30TH 2021**



All lodge dues are now \$55 (for men and women). It is also \$55 to renew ALL dues. This promotion ended July 31st which waved the \$20 application fee.

If a man wants to join the Moose Legion it is a an additional \$16. If a woman wants to join the WOTM Chapter it is an additional \$15\*. You must be a member of the lodge to be a member of the Moose Legion or or WOTM Chapter. Any member can sponsor a new male or female member into the Lodge, but a male must sponsor a male into the Moose Legion and a female must sponsor a female into the WOTM Chapter.

\*If you were a member prior to April 30, 2021 and your dues remain current, your Chapter dues are covered for three years from your WOTM expiration date on your WOTM card as of April 30, 2021
