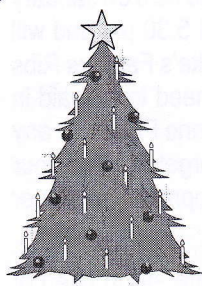

Season's Greetings!

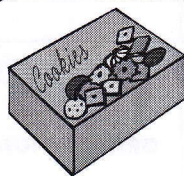

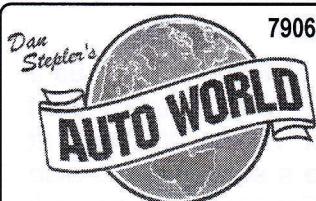
