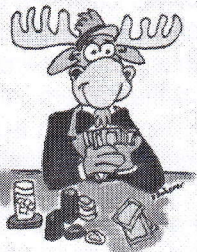
### **ADDRESS CHANGE?**

Happy New Year!!!

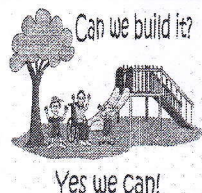

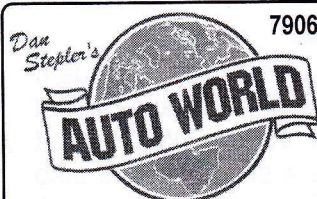
