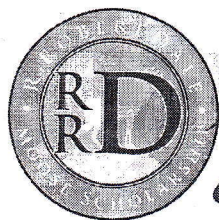

Hello Everyone!

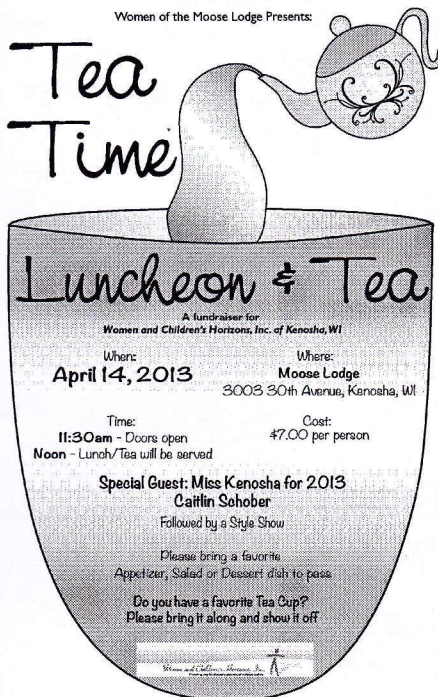
