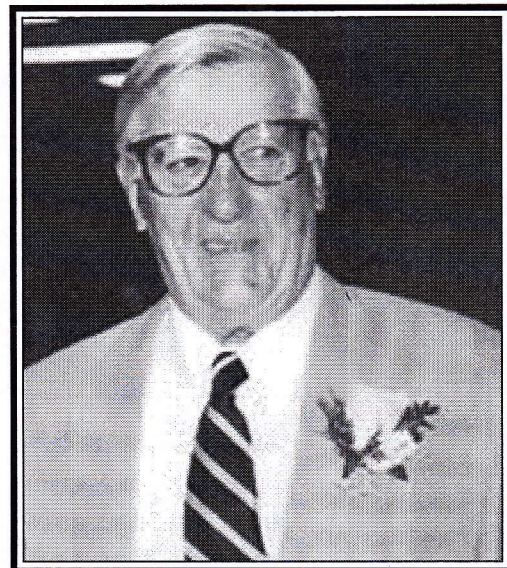

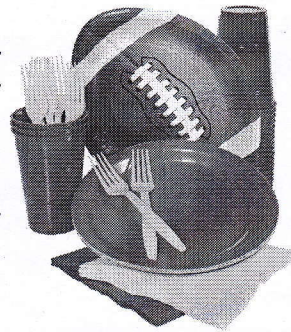
### Help needed Harbor Market

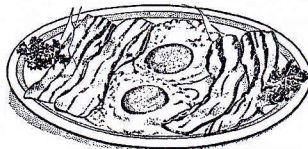

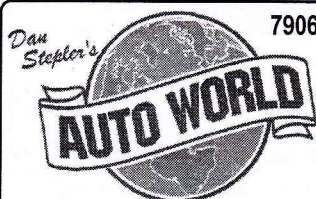
